School: One building provides the education for 74 elementary students (grades PreK-5), 25 middle school students (grades 6-8), and 38 high school students (grades 9-12). The school also provides half-day preschool classes for students who have been identified as special needs and other children in the community. Additionally, our school district has a four-day school week and is proud of our small teacher-to-student class ratios.

Bancroft is part of the picturesque Gem Valley in Southeastern Idaho. It is a quiet community with approximately 390 residents. Our town lies in the midst of the Caribou

Bancroft sits at an elevation of 5,420 feet above sea level. It is also a railroad town and lies on the historic route of old U.S. Highway 30.
