## Advancement Requirements (Grades 6 through 9)

The District has established a set of advancement requirements for $6^{\text {th }}$ through $9^{\text {th }}$ grade students which will act as a guide in helping students move methodically and purposefully on a course that will eventually lead to high school graduation. Therefore, the District sets the following advancement requirements:

1. To advance to the $7^{\text {th }}$ grade, students must earn at least 80 percent of the credits attempted in $6^{\text {th }}$ grade and be in compliance with the District's attendance policy;
2. To advance to the $8^{\text {th }}$ grade, students must earn at least 80 percent of the credits attempted in $7^{\text {th }}$ grade and be in compliance with the District's attendance policy.
3. To advance to the $9^{\text {th }}$ grade, students must earn at least 80 percent of the credits attempted in $8^{\text {th }}$ grade and be in compliance with the District's attendance policy; and
4. Students who have failed more than 20 percent of the courses attempted in the $6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$, or eighth $8^{\text {th }}$ grade may make up the credits needed to achieve the minimum portion of credits attempted by retaking the necessary course(s) during the summer, online, or through correspondence.
